- Make a graph or graphs showing the area and population of each archipelago on your chart.

S. America – Bays - 1

- Mark and label the bays of South America on a map of the continent. Write the names of the bays on a chart.
- Enter the name of the country in which each bay is located and the body of water adjoining it.
- Enter the location of each bay on your chart.

South America – Bays - 2

- Write a short description of each of the bays.
- Write a paragraph explaining how each bay got its name.
- Enter the name(s) of the river(s) that flow into each bay.
- Enter your sources on note cards.

South America – Capes - 1

- Mark and label the capes of South America on a map of the continent. Write the names of the capes on a chart.
- On your chart, enter the location of each cape, the name of the country in which it is located.
- Write the name of the ocean or sea surrounding the cape on the chart.

South America – Capes - 2

- Write a short description of each of the capes.
- Write a paragraph explaining how each cape got its name.
- Enter your sources on note cards.
